ORDINANCE NO. 697

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ODESSA AMENDING SECTION 6.08.030E(2) DANGEROUS DOG OF THE ODESSA MUNICIPAL CODE, TO FURTHER HELP EXPLAIN THE DEFINITION OF DANGEROUS DOG

WHEREAS the Town Council desires to amend the Odessa Municipal Code Section 6.08.030E(2) Dangerous Dogs to include the wording "inflicts severe injury" to further help explain the definition of dangerous dogs; and

WHEREAS the Town Council deems by adding this wording it will further explain the difference between the definitions of dangerous and potentially dangerous dogs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ODESSA, LINCOLN COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS, TO WIT:

SECTION 1. Amend section 6.08.030E(2) to now read:

(2) inflicts severe injury or kills a domestic animal without provocation while the dog is off the owner's property,

SECTION 2. Amend and Adopt changes by resolution.

The Odessa Town Council is hereby allowed to amend and adopt changes to Ordinance No. 697 by resolution.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any provision of the ordinance or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance, or the application of the provisions to other person or circumstances, shall not be affected.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
